




From the Music Director

Liturgical Guidelines from the new Directory of Catechesis

The liturgical magazine *GIA Quarterly* explains: "the new *Directory for Catechesis* considers both the opportunities and the challenges the Church faces in an ever more global and secular society. Building upon the Second Vatican Council, the Catechism of the Catholic Church, and the ongoing work of the new evangelization, it gives several guidelines for liturgy:

- 1) Do parishioners see and welcome strangers as we gather for liturgy before Mass begins?
- 2) Do we sing hymns and Mass parts with a sense of freedom and joy?
- 3) Is the Eucharistic Prayer a joyful sacrifice of praise? Are the acclamations sung by the entire baptismal priesthood? (That's us!)
- 4) Is the communion procession a joyful expression of the unity of the People of God? (Or do we try to make it a time of personal devotion? We shouldn't!)
- 5) Is the final hymn a joyful call to the freedom of God's saving love?



As we continue our journey of encounter with the mystery of Jesus Christ, doing these things will shape a faith community into being not only well-informed but deeply transformed by the richness of the liturgical experience.






