


Litany of the Saints

From the Music Director

The editor of *Today's Liturgy* writes "As we approach the solemnity of All Saints and the Commemoration of All the Faithful Departed this week, let's take a moment to reflect on the litany and its saints. The veneration of saints is an ancient part of our faith. Forms of the litany appeared as early as the third century and it's still in use at the Easter Vigil, the Rites of Holy Orders, and the baptism of children. After the angels, apostles, disciples, and Mary, the most venerable were martyrs – those who died for their faith. Next were saints who did not shed blood but suffered for their faith through imprisonment, torture, or exile. After the age of persecution, the substitute for martyrdom became the ascetical life. Virginity consecrated to the Lord was revered as a form of denial and suffering. Holy widows were included if they dedicated themselves to helping the poor or other charitable works. Beloved bishops were included because their people wanted to remember them. (cf. The Church of Prayer, Vol. IV, A.G. Martimor, ed, Collegeville, MN: Liturgical Press, 1992)."


