

I am sure, like me, you are wondering where the year has gone, and maybe looking ahead, starting to anticipate the holiday season. The other day at a staff meeting I was happy to see all the wonderful events that are planned for Thanksgiving, Advent, Christmas, and the New Year. I hope you can join the St. Kevin Parish community for the different variety of things that are going on. And when you come, I ask you not to come alone; please invite family and friends to the dinners, concerts, and liturgical celebrations. When we are together, we are stronger. Also, when we share our Faith in community, we make a difference in each others lives.



I also, want to draw your attention to two important fundraising events that are ongoing during this season.

First, the Annual Catholic Appeal began during Lent 2023 and extends to the end of the calendar year. Many of you have already made a contribution to the Bishop's request for assistance. Your donations provide funding for the Corporal and Spiritual Works of Mercy to be present in our Diocese. This year, St. Kevin's goal is \$108,738.00. Because of your generosity we are less that \$5000 shy of this mark. I want to thank all who have been able to support this year's appeal and I ask all who have not yet made a pledge or contribution to do so at this time. While the Appeal helps the diocese, it also helps the parish when we go over our goal. Donations over the goal come back to the parish for our use. If you donate now, it will certainly help both the Bishop and the Parish of St. Kevin.

The second event is the parish's Bright Lights Blessed Christmas Fundraiser. In this week's bulletin and on the parish webpage, www.stkevinflushing.org, there is an order form to reserve and memorialize Trees, Angels, Wreaths, and Poinsettias that are used thru the season to decorate the parish grounds and sanctuary. You will be able to see the display from Sunday December 10<sup>th</sup> through Christmas, until Sunday January 7<sup>th</sup>, The Baptism of the Lord. The lighting ceremony will take place on Sunday December 10<sup>th</sup> at 4pm. We will start in Church with a short concert and then go outside to light the trees and grounds. Please mark your calendars and join us as we together remember our loved ones and begin to celebrate the birth of our savior this Christmas Season.

### From the Music Director

### Eternal Father, Strong to Save

When the headmaster of England's Winchester College Choristers' School learned a student was about to sail to the United States, he wrote a poem invoking the Most Holy Trinity to keep him safe at sea. In 1861 it was set to music by an English clergyman, Rev. John Dykes, who composed many well-known hymns, including "Holy, Holy, Holy" and "Nearer, My God to Thee". He called the tune MELITA, the old name for Malta, which is the site of the shipwreck St. Paul writes about in chapters 27-28 in Acts of the Apostles.

In 1879, the United States Naval Academy started the practice, still in use today, of concluding each Sunday's Divine Services by singing it, causing it to become known as the "Navy Hymn". Bishop Robert N. Spencer altered the last three verses for the 1937 U.S. Episcopalian hymnal to recognize additional modes of transportation used in the military: on land for the army and in the air for the air force.

It's been heard in the TV series 24 and JAG, as well as the movies Crimson Tide, The Right Stuff, The Perfect

Storm and Titanic, though that film mistakenly uses the 1930's verses that

hadn't been written yet in 1912. God bless our veterans!





To the Clergy, Staffs and the Faithful parishioners of Brooklyn and Queens,

Recently, I met with our Vicar General, Regional Vicars, local Deans and priests during our annual Priest Convocation in Douglaston. During this gathering, we discussed important issues that we will need to address in the near future, like new models of parish life, possible collaborations among parishes regarding Religious Education and other ministries, as well as assessing the current Mass schedules at all our parishes.

Allow me to share with you some statistics that were shared with the priests:

- In 2017, Mass attendance in our Diocese was reported at an average of 205,502 people per weekend. In 2022, the average was reported at 124,031. Due to demographic changes as well as the overall national trend of fewer Catholics attending Sunday Mass regularly, we see a decrease of nearly 40 percent in Mass attendance in our diocese in the last 5 years. This decline in Mass attendance means that we have in many parishes throughout the diocese large capacity churches with a significantly reduced Mass size.
- Due to a high number of priest retirements and deaths in recent years, there are fewer priests serving in our 175 parishes.
- In our diocese Mass is celebrated in 14 different languages on a weekly basis and in 26 languages monthly. This unique pastoral challenge in combination with the reduced number of clergy with bi-lingual skills further complicates the ability to best serve our parishes with specific language needs.

There is no simple solution to these issues. In many of our parishes it is evident that we do not need so many separate Masses to accommodate the number of parishioners in attendance at Sunday Eucharist each week. We are asking pastors and administrators throughout the diocese in Brooklyn and Queens, in consultation with their pastoral councils, to review and evaluate their Mass schedules. In many parishes, the number of Masses celebrated each weekend could be reduced by at least one or maybe more Masses, depending on the number of people attending and the capacity of each church.

Additionally, your pastor in coordination with your Regional Vicar and local Dean, are beginning discussions at the deanery level concerning possible collaborations among neighboring parishes regarding Religious Education programs and other ministries, that could possibly lead to formal parish partnerships.

I ask for your openness and cooperation with these possible changes. Not every parish will be affected, but most will go through some sort of adjustment, in order to be able to most effectively serve the current needs of the People of God in our great Diocese.

Be assured of my prayers for each of you, and may I humbly ask for your prayers, especially for our pastors and administrators, and all those who will be part of these discussions taking place throughout our parishes and deaneries.
