From the Music Director

Lo, How a Rose E'er Blooming

Es ist ein Ros entsprungen (literally "A rose has sprung up") is a German carol, most commonly translated into English as "Lo, How a Rose E'er Blooming." It refers to the Old Testament prophecies of Isaiah foretelling the Incarnation of Christ, and to the Tree of Jesse, a traditional symbol of the lineage of Jesus. The legend behind it is that a monk was walking through the forest late one winter night and found a rose. Inspired by its beauty, he placed the flower at an altar to the Virgin Mary.

The text has its roots in an unknown author from the 15th century. Its manuscript was found in the Carthusian Monastery of St Alban in Trier, Germany, and is now preserved in the City Library. It has since been published with a varying number of verses (up to 23!) and in several translations.



The tune was first printed in 1599 in Cologne, Germany, and the famous composer Michael Praetorius helped its popularity by harmonizing it in his collection of hymns in 1609. His arrangement still appears in our hymnal today! So like that monk long ago, let the image of the rose in the cold midwinter remind you of the unexpected as we celebrate Christ's birth.


