From the Music Director

Here I Am, Lord

Dan Schutte was studying theology in Berkeley, CA, when a friend asked him to write a song for a diaconate ordination Mass three days later. His friend wanted the song to include images of the word of God, the light of Christ and the bread and wine—images that would eventually appear at the ends of the verses: "Who will bear my light to them?" and "Who will speak my word to them?"

Since he often uses Scripture as the basis of his songs, he turned to the stories of the prophets, like Jeremiah, who asked God to give him the right words to say. "All of those people God was calling to be prophets have expressed their self-doubt," Schutte told the Jesuit magazine *America*. That's why he changed the lyrics from a confident "Here I am, Lord; here I stand, Lord" to the self-doubting final version: "Here I am, Lord; is it I, Lord?"

Some critics complain that the verses "make me sing the part of God!" But Dan wrote the song as a call-andresponse; meaning a soloist is supposed to sing the verse and the congregation responds. This enables the dialog between the Lord (verses) and the people (refrain) to unfold without confusion. Try listening and responding, and see if it helps you pray more deeply.




