



From the Music Director

What is the ministry of the choir?

The choir supports the congregational singing by singing along with it, sometimes in harmony! It also sings by itself sometimes, attempting to allow the listener to enter a deeper sense of prayer. By singing occasionally in other languages, the choir honors both the long tradition of sacred music and the international dimension of the church. It tries to reach the depths of our emotion and soar to the heights of the glory of God.

We need a continuing supply of people to build up the ranks of our choir, especially sopranos! Joining the choir provides an opportunity to offer a unique and costly sacrifice of praise to God. It takes a commitment to come to rehearsal. Some choir members have devoted themselves to this ministry for years. Some take the music home and work on it between rehearsals. But it also develops the individual choir member as a person, as a Christian, and as a musician. Each singer is surrounded by peers drilling notes, studying texts, absorbing the music, feeling the passion, and that singer has no choice but to improve their own understanding of these

things. So, if you think the choir might be for you, come to a rehearsal!




