From the Music Director

Our 2nd Annual SKCA Piano Recital!

This Monday, February 5th, St. Kevin Catholic Academy students and I will present our 2nd Annual Piano Recital at 6:30 PM here in our church on our Boston grand piano! Please come and support us! You'll hear some beginning piano selections as well as two pieces by Beethoven, *Für Elise* and *Ode to Joy*; and a Chopin Nocturne, a short piece of a dreamy character suggestive of night. Contemporary selections include Gloria Gaynor's disco anthem "I Will Survive" and Elton John's "Tiny Dancer." I'm going to play Debussy's *La cathédrale engloutie*, translated as "The Sunken Cathedral." This 45-minute recital is free and open to the public, so please bring your friends!

In 1840, Franz Liszt held two performances that he called *Liszt's Pianoforte Recitals*. This was the first time anyone used the word recital to refer to a musical event. (Before this, the term was applied strictly to dramatic readings.) He deviated from concerts at that time by taking time between pieces to recite, or talk, to the audience. He also turned the piano sideways so the audience could see his profile and watch his fingers fly across the keys. He literally "set the stage" for our modern piano recitals.
