

The Bandura

A bandura is a Ukrainian stringed folk instrument. It combines elements of the zither and lute and, up until the 1940s, was also referred to as a kobza. Originally it had 5 to 12 strings, but in the 20th century, the number of strings increased up to 56–68 strings on modern 'concert' instruments.

In 2022, John Legend premiered his new song "Free", dedicated to the fallen citizens of Ukraine amid the country's ongoing war with Russia. It featured a bandurist, and he tweeted the inspiration behind it – "FREE is a prayer. It's a prayer for peace throughout the world. A prayer for all the dispossessed and dislocated. I know I can't end any wars with a song, but I had to write this song as my prayer, my contribution to the chorus of voices calling for peace and freedom for all people."

Lesya Verba is a bandurist, singer, songwriter, and muralist. She came to New York from Odessa, Ukraine.



She's won numerous musical competitions throughout Europe, and released a recording called Golden in 2020. She played here Easter Sunday 2022, and once again she and I are playing together Easter Sunday morning. As we celebrate the resurrection of our Lord Jesus Christ, let's pray for the resurrection of world peace...




