From the Music Director

Do you sing during the entrance procession?

The liturgical magazine *GIA Quarterly* explains: “The entrance procession is part of the Mass’s Introductory Rites ‘to ensure that the faithful, who come together as one, establish communion and dispose themselves properly to listen to the Word of God and to celebrate the Eucharist worthily’ (GIRM 46). It fosters unity within those gathered (through singing together) and the hymn introduces the assembly to the particularity of each liturgy.

Not all liturgical singing is equally important, a hierarchy exists: First in importance are the Gospel Acclamation and Eucharistic Acclamations; and following closely after are the Responsorial Psalm, the Entrance Song, and the Communion Song (which also accompanies a procession). Processions are fully realized only when accompanied by song. ‘Singing is the sign of the heart’s joy’ (GIRM 39). Singing in the liturgy enables certain ritual elements to function properly, like the entrance procession.

The ‘best practice’ means a procession of all liturgical ministers through the rest of the assembly accompanied by the singing of a seasonally appropriate song sung by all the faithful.” Do you sing during the entrance procession?

Stewardship Education and Reflections on the Weekly Mass Readings



April 14, 2024 Third Sunday in Easter

In addition to celebrating all Christ did for us this Easter season, we also are reminded of how His sacrifice impacts our lives.

Today's Gospel reminds us that Jesus should be the center of our lives. This passage begins with two disciples realizing Jesus had just appeared to them.

We can learn a valuable lesson from these disciples. To recognize Jesus' appearances in our lives, we need to know Him. And the best way to know the Lord is to spend time with Him. It can start with just 10 minutes of quiet prayer a day and increasing that each week. We might begin by reading Scripture, books on the lives of the Saints, or even a decade of the Rosary. Yet the goal should be to carve out time each day, in a quiet space, for just you and the Lord.

As the disciples mentioned, they recognized it was Jesus in the breaking of the bread. We, too, can better know the Lord through the sacraments, most especially the Holy Mass. The Eucharist is Jesus Himself — Body, Blood Soul, and Divinity. What better way to grow in intimacy with Christ than to receive Him frequently or to go talk to Him in front of the Blessed Sacrament? As we make Jesus the center of our lives through prayer and the sacraments, we will be able to recognize Him in day-to-day moments.

As we are still in the midst of this Easter season, take time to think about what Christ did for us and the changes we should make in our daily lives to help us grow closer to Him. **@Catholic Stewardship Consultants**

Registration for September 2024

The St. Kevin Office of Religious Education provides a comprehensive faith formation program for children in grades 1-8 that do not attend a Catholic School.

Registration for September, 2024 Religious Education classes is ongoing thru September. Families who are already in our program will receive notification via email. Any families new to the program can visit our parish website for the on-line registration form at: <https://stkevinflushing.org/faith-formation/registration>. All new children or families please include in your email your child's baptismal certificate plus vaccination record, which are needed for registration. Our classes will be as follows:

Classes will be remote two Sunday's a month and in school two Sunday's. Sunday Mass attendance is required for all families in our program. Families are asked to attend the 9:00 AM mass with their children. Then the children will go to the school for instruction from 10:00 AM to 11:00 AM. Parents are invited to the Parish Hall for an Adult session while your children are in class. Remote classes will be scheduled on Sunday morning. If you are not able the 9:00 AM Mass, please choose another mass to fulfill your Sunday Obligation.

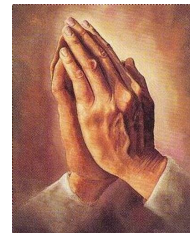
