## From the Music Director

## Amazing Grace

John Newton was a musically talented British sailor who came of age as the 18<sup>th</sup> century boasted an international empire of slavery. Torn between following in his slave-trading father's footsteps or embracing the compassionate views of his childhood sweetheart, nearly drowning at sea led him to become an Anglican clergyman and abolitionist. And caused him to pen this hymn!

The tune, NEW BRITAIN, is based on the pentatonic scale, which only has 5 notes in it instead of our diatonic scale that has 8. (All windchimes are based on this scale, so you could play "Amazing Grace" on your windchimes, or on the black notes of your piano!) The enslaved people used this scale to create their songs, and this melody may well have been sung on the slave ships, though the harmonies would have sounded much different, much more plaintive.

With the message that redemption is possible regardless of past sins and that the soul can be delivered from despair through the mercy of God, "Amazing Grace" is estimated to be sung nearly ten million times a year! It's become a song that inspires hope in the wake of tragedy, becoming a sort of "spiritual national anthem." President Barack Obama recited and later sang the hymn at the memorial service for one of the nine victims of the Charleston church shooting in 2015.

# The Catholic Steward

Stewardship Education and Reflections on the Weekly Mass Readings



Our readings today remind us that God always best interests in mind. No matter what is going on in our lives, God is with us.

In our Gospel today, Jesus and His disciples are traveling in a boat when heavy winds and violent waves begin to overwhelm the boat. Jesus was there sleeping in the boat in the midst of this horrific storm.

The disciples woke Jesus and questioned Him, “Teacher, do you not care that we are perishing?” Jesus calms the wind and the waves, and then asks them in return, “Why are you terrified? Do you not yet have faith?”

Think back to a time that you endured great suffering, a hard trial or felt overwhelmed with life. How did you respond?

In moments of trial, we often live our days in a panic. We see the water coming into our boat and we do all that we can in our power to stay afloat. We are frantic, so we fail to stop and recognize that our Savior is in the same boat with us. Although it might feel like He is sleeping and His presence is lacking, He is right there suffering with us.

God won’t allow anything that we cannot handle. In a moment of suffering, we might feel trapped. Yet, He sees the moment of peace and still waters.

During our trials, cling to Jesus. Know that there is an end, and whether we see the end in this life or the next, God allows it all for our salvation.

Today, let us thank God for His presence in our lives, and ask for the eyes of faith to see that He is right here with us always.

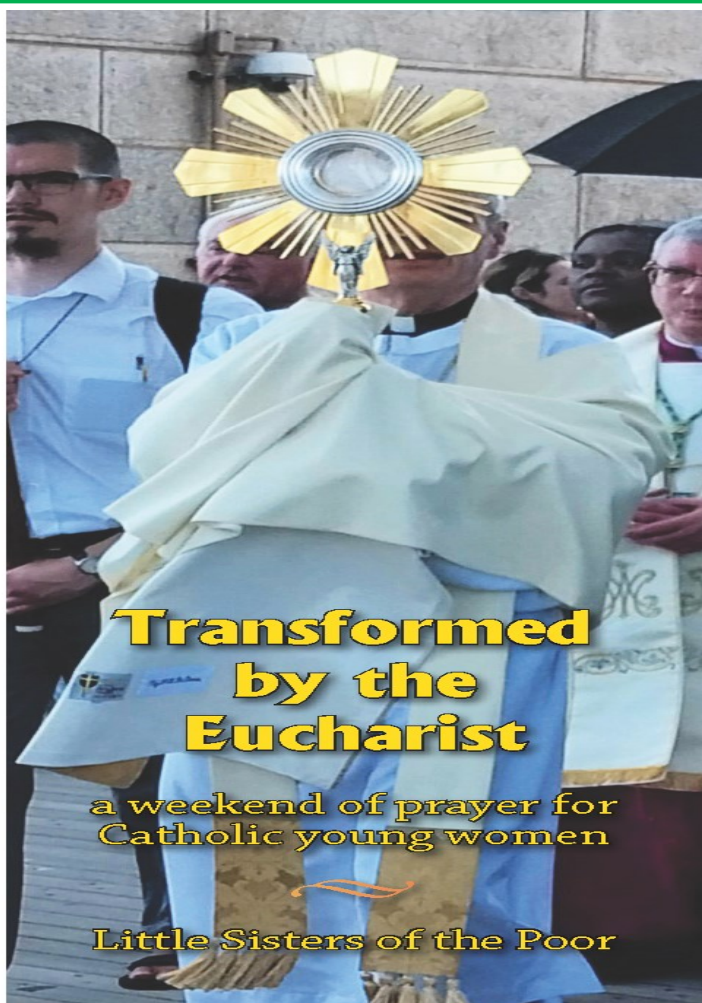

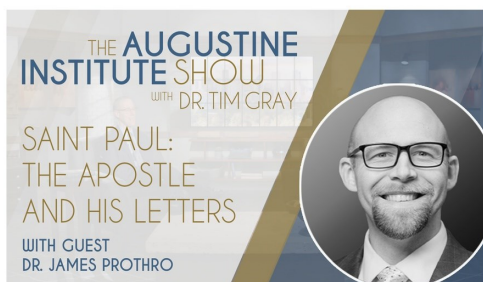
